

**Greater Rockridge NCPC (12Y/13X) – Minutes**

Mike Ubell opened the meeting at 7:40 PM. No Community Resource Officers attending (Officer Hutzol was on vacation and Officer Jurgen was assigned to cover a demonstration). Two citizens attended the meeting.

A resident asked about the recent shooting at BART station – is there any status, and why wasn't it on Nixle? Mike Ubell responded that we've heard it wasn't a robbery, it was an altercation between people in the BART parking lot. We have no clear information. Since it happened in the BART lot, it's probably being managed by BART Police, who don't use Nixle.

Aubyn Merie (co-chair, Temescal Community Council) asked if we have set any priorities. Mike Ubell responded that our Community Resource Officer is usually aware of recent crime trends, and working on them, so we haven't set any NCPC priorities recently. Ms. Merie asked what are our biggest concerns? We said the main one was car break-ins and burglaries. Ms. Merie said the Temescal group is now a Neighborhood Council and meets every other month. They're getting a lot of neighborhood issues, like traffic, and someone wants to start a brewery. Mike Ubell said that neighborhood concerns in Rockridge tend to be handled by Rockridge Community Planning Council.

No new priorities were set. With only 2 citizens present and no police officers attending, the NCPC officers decided to adjourn early, at 8 pm. The scheduled speaker had not confirmed that she would attend and hadn't arrived by 8 PM.

***NCPC Priorities for September 2015***

Under new OPD rules, each beat is allowed a single priority, instead of the previous 3; and new priorities must be *identifiable* and *measurable*. Community Resource Officers will also work on a *Crime project* and *from time to time* (?) a *Call reduction project* for the beat. Remember that 12Y and 13X are only part of beats 12 and 13.

**12Y:**

1. *NCPC Priority*: No current priority.
2. *Crime Project*: High visibility vehicle patrols on College Avenue between Broadway and Claremont
3. *Call Reduction Project*: to be announced

**13X:**

1. *NCPC Priority*: No current priority.
2. *Crime Project*: none at present.
3. *Call Reduction Project*: to be announced
