Sergeant Manguy did some looking in the stats database he has access to, which appears to be a different database than the one at the "open data" site that Karen uses, and identified some of the incidents in Karen's September list, but also saw some not in her list. They may show up in next month's download.

The resident said that he had no particular incidents to discuss, he was just here to "show support." We made no changes to the priorities. Karen Ivy closed the meeting just after 7:20 PM.
